PCN priorities	Proactive Care Frameworks champion	<ul> <li>Champion to share why they are interested in implementing frameworks and how they think it will support PCN priorities</li> <li>Prompt other key stakeholders to share priorities and existing work related to long-term conditions, personalisation, remote monitoring and/or workforce         <ul> <li>Note: prepare key stakeholders ahead of meeting, asking them to share these priorities and discuss how they link in with the Proactive Care Frameworks</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	
Overview of Proactive Care Frameworks	Proactive Care Frameworks champion / ICS / AHSN partner	<ul> <li>Your local AHSN may be able to attend these meetings and speak to this agenda item</li> <li>Focus this on a high level overview that shares the key principles of the frameworks and use one condition to exemplify how it works in practice.</li> <li><i>Note:</i> in preparatory meetings with stakeholders, find out what conditions may be a priority and select this as the condition to focus</li> </ul>	



Discussion	Proactive Care Frameworks champion	<ul> <li>on. Also review the UCLP resources on the website to become familiar with resources that can support implementation</li> <li>Discuss the multi-morbidity approach and refer to the relevant resources</li> <li>It is important to highlight that these are truly <i>frameworks</i> which can and should be adapted to fit the local context</li> <li>Open a discussion to seek thoughts from the groups about their interest in implementing the frameworks.</li> <li>Key questions: <ul> <li>How can the frameworks support delivery of existing work?</li> <li>What conditions should be a priority?</li> <li>What are the enablers and barriers to doing this work?</li> <li>What support may we need to implement this?</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	
Next steps	PCN Clinical Director	<ul> <li>How can staff be shared across the PCN?</li> <li>Key next steps may be:         <ul> <li>A further meeting to continue the discussion</li> <li>A meeting with other key stakeholders who are key partners to deliver the work.
