- Theory of change, report – lead PSCs and MedSIP national team

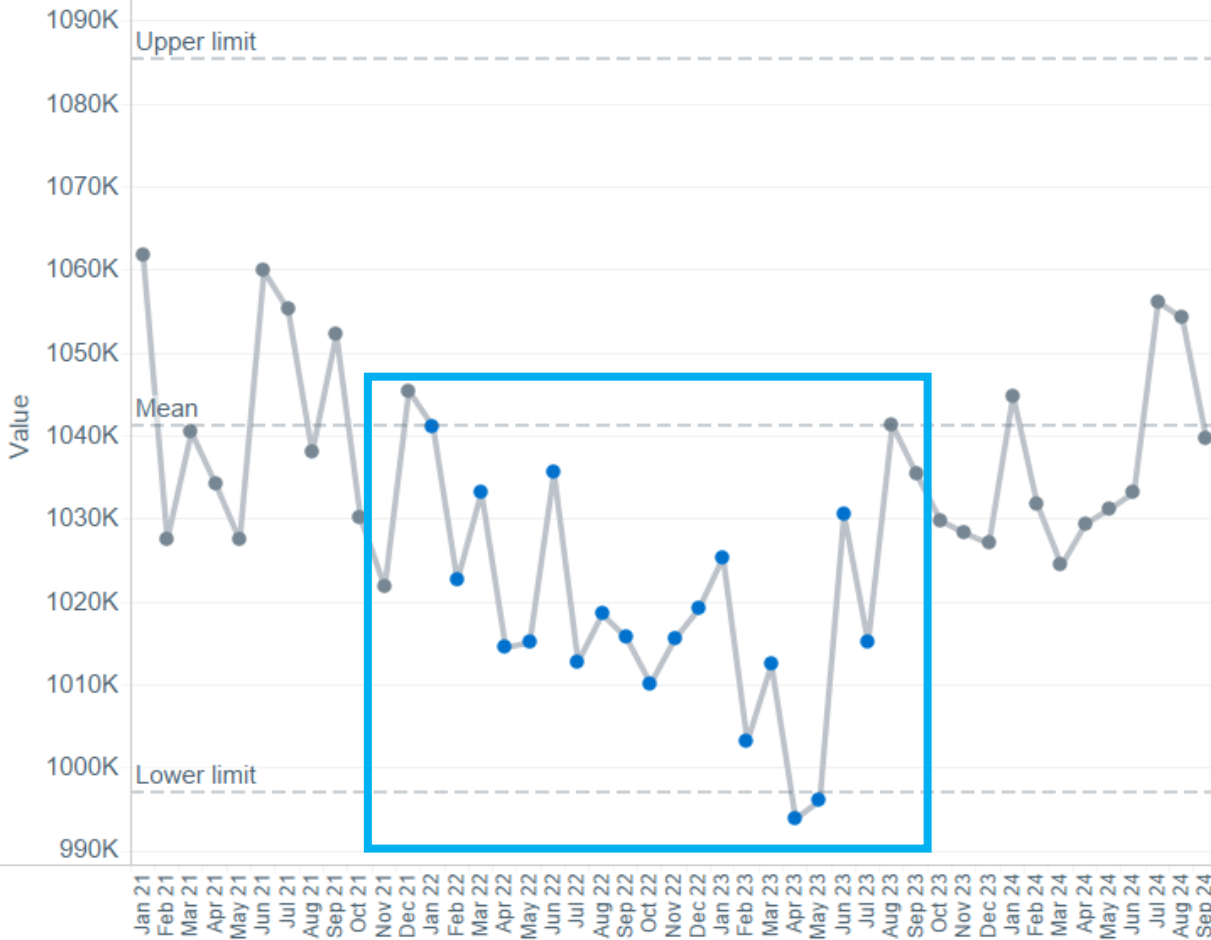


MedSIP Update – National Data (PAIN03 and OP04)

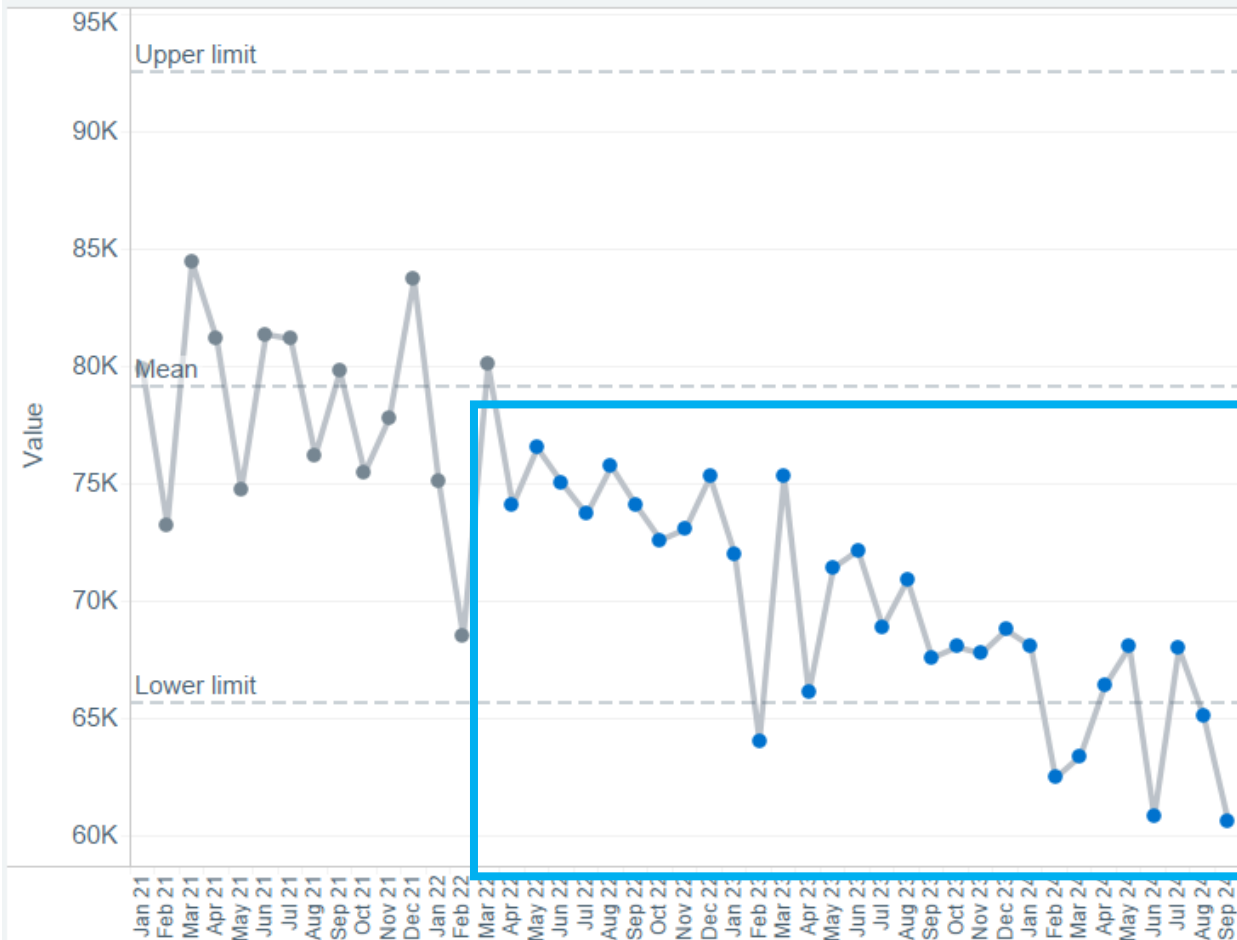

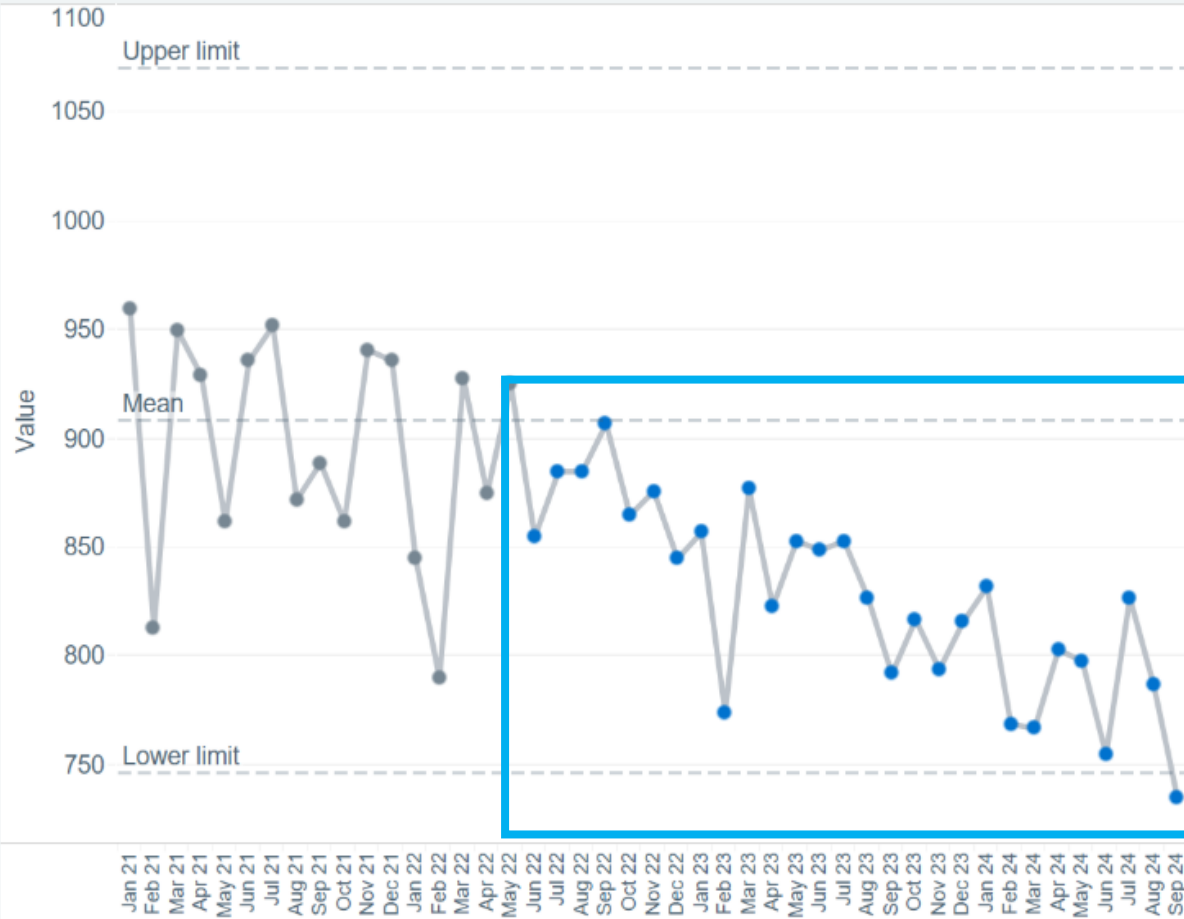

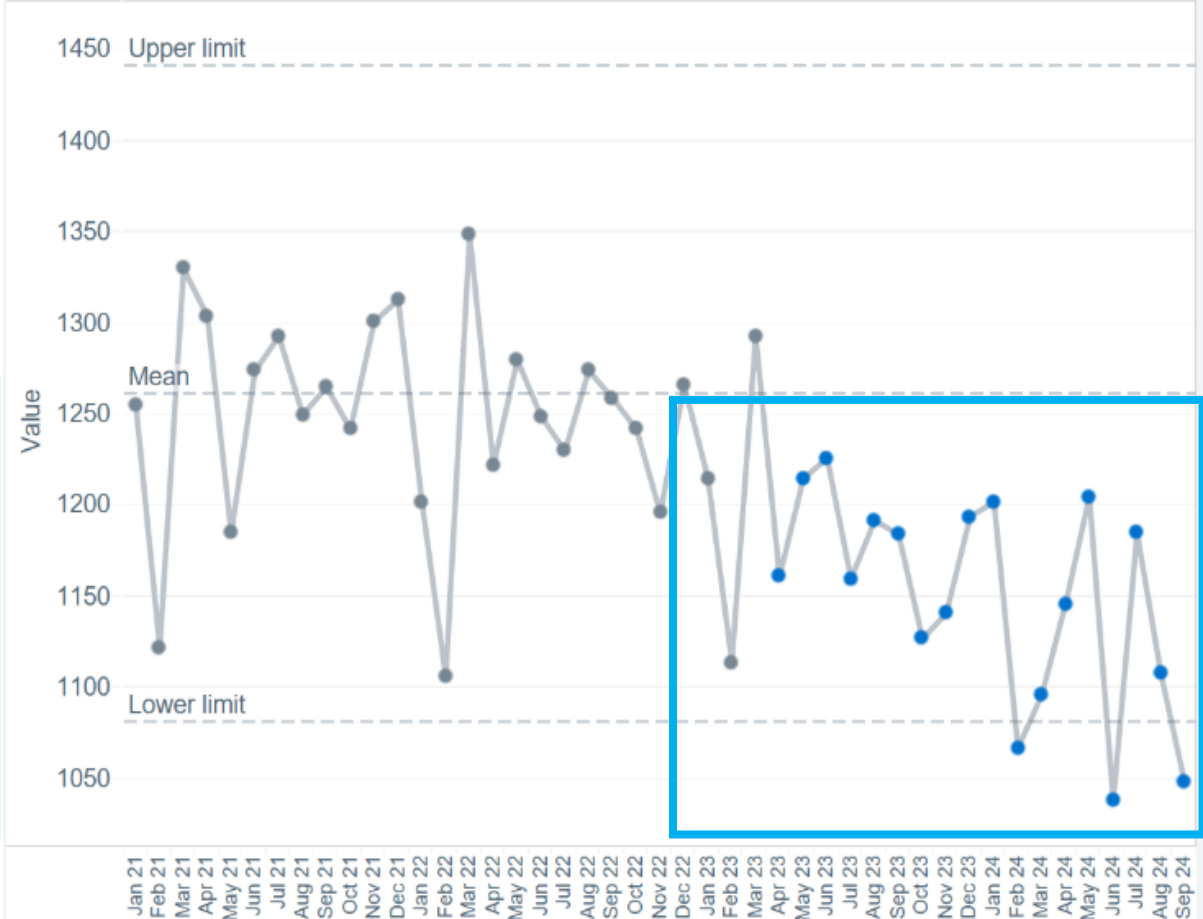

Opiate Pathway:

- Establish opioid dependency
- Methadone, buprenorphine, espranor or buvidal....
- Titration & collection regime



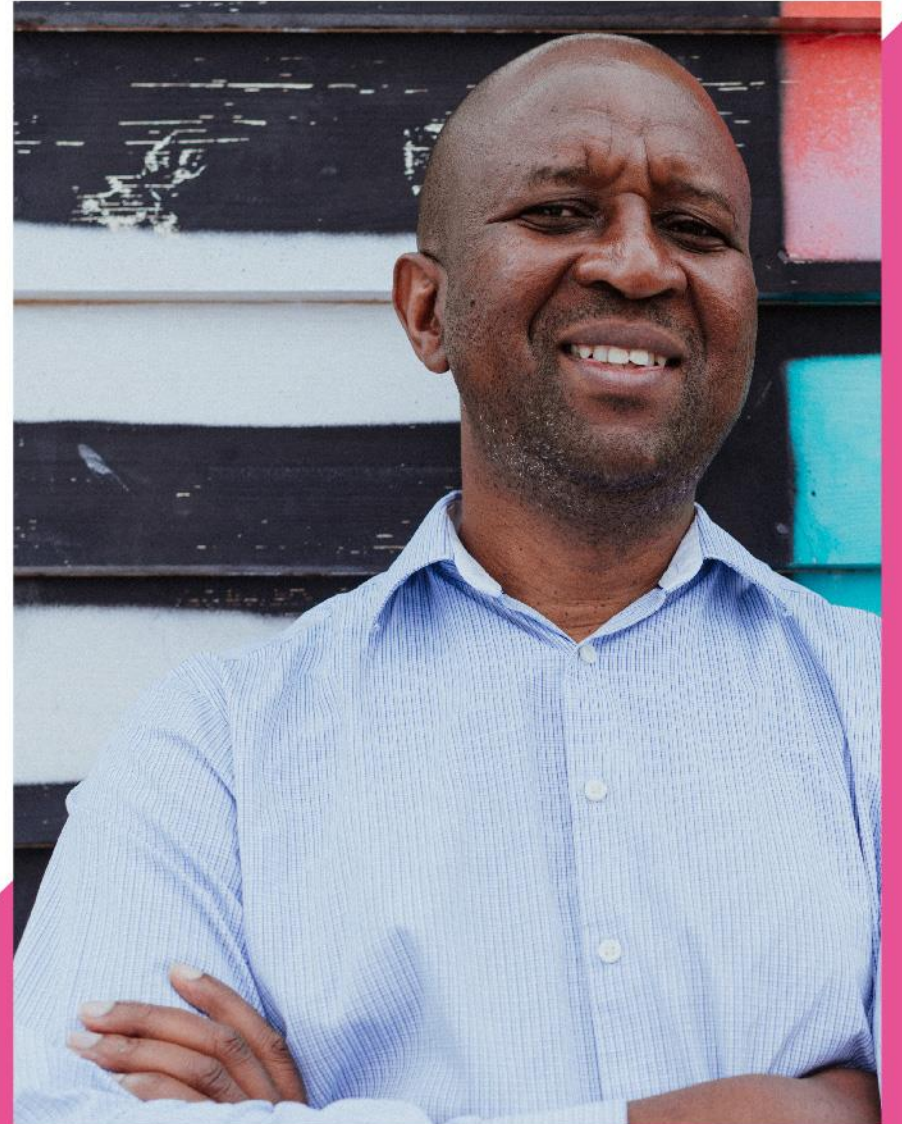
Challenges:

- Clients falling off script
- Difficulty in keeping appointments
- Daily supervised collection
- Impacts on travel & other commitments
- Clients in hospital & continuity of care



How do we Mitigate?

- Strong relationships with hospitals & other services
- Rapid restarts
- Daily restart clinic & restart clinics in hostels
- Combining appointments
- Utilising other professionals & networks
- Holiday scripts





Harm Reduction & Rapid Response to Synthetic Opiates:

- Restart clinics in hostels
- Naloxone delivery & training in administering naloxone for all client or partner agencies.
- Drug testing strips

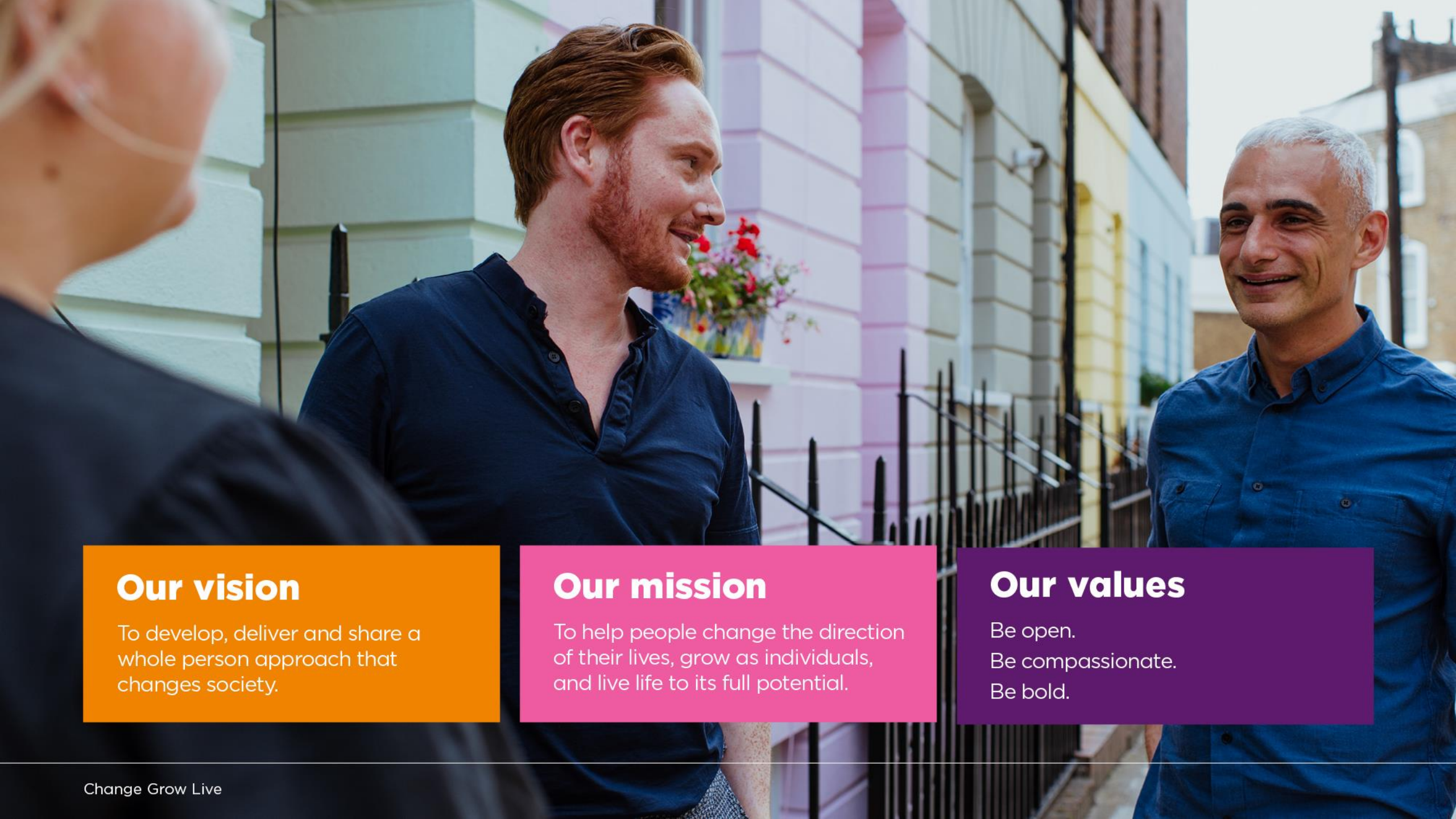
