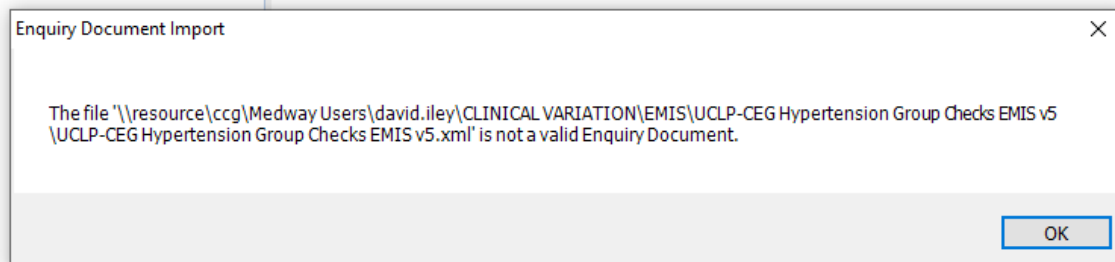


## Search and Stratification tool FAQs

### Question 1:

I have tried to extract the hypertension search, but I get the following error when I try to import the search into EMIS



### Answer 1:

It seems that the standard searches do not work on some EMIS systems using older software, this can be resolved with a “nofolder” version – if you get this error message please contact UCLP and we will send you a different version of the searches which will work ok.

### Question 2:

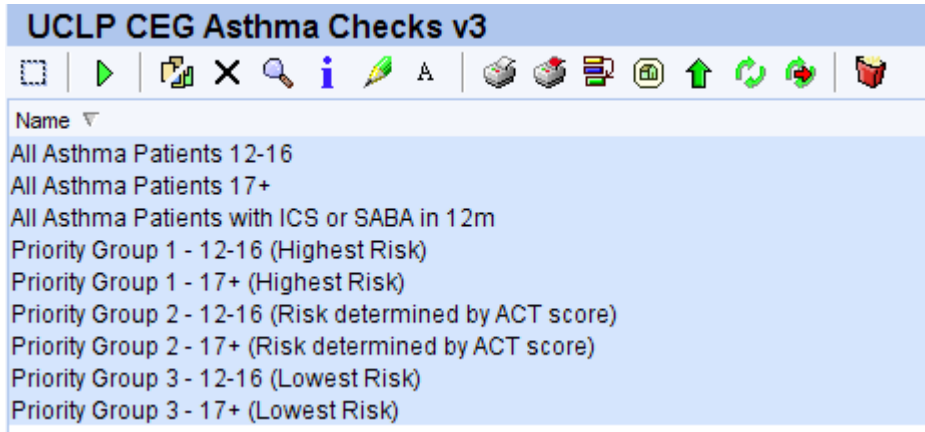
I have imported the searches and run them in S1 however I am a little confused as to which reports in each section I actually have to run (as opposed to them being a sub-report). What do search outputs and priority groups mean?

### Answer 2:

See below screenshots and also the attached list of ALL reports (in appendix) which shows the main searches you will need for the Risk stratification searches. Any other sub-searches that appear during the import process can be moved out into a different folder.

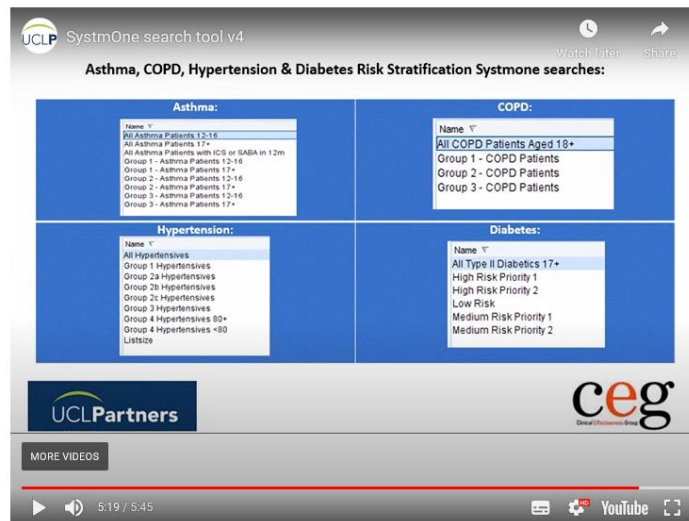
Priority Groups are listed in order 1 = highest priority and Priority groups 2,3,4,5 are in descending order with lowest priority last.

We have now renamed the search outputs to indicate this - asthma example for SystmOne below



**Question 3:**

I have followed the instruction to import the searches on SystmOne but there are few searches that I cannot find that says in SystmOne search tool's video. Diabetes searches I cannot find "High risk priority 1, Medium risk priority 1 and Medium risk priority 2".
